Copia's House Labelle/Vignoles, Columbia, Missouri, \$7 glass/ \$23 liter

With a rich floral nose, this fresh white wine delivers a hint of sweetness and a crisp subtle finish.

NxNW, Riesling, Columbia Valley, \$9 glass/\$27 liter

Notes of lime and rose petal, refreshing acidity, mellow sweetness and dry, lingering finish.

Edna Valley, Chardonnay, San Luis Obispo County, \$8 glass/\$25 liter

On the nose apricot and light pineapple, with brown spice notes. Hints of vanilla, a bright acidity, medium-bodied wine.

Edna Valley, Sauvignon Blanc, Central Coast, \$8 glass/\$25 liter

Vibrant currant-leaf, citrus and gooseberry aromas. Full-flavored, with grapefruit and citrus, and a dry, clean finish.

Acrobat, Pinot Gris, Oregon \$9 glass/\$29 liter

Bright citrus and honeysuckle notes complimented by green apple and a lingering minerality.

Joel Gott, Un-Oaked Chardonnay, California, 2013, \$11

Tropical aromas of melon and pineapple that lead to bright citrus flavors and a hint of vanilla.

Girard, Chardonnay, Russian River Valley 2013, \$14

Elegant nose of citrus, pear, and butterscotch leads to apple, fresh cream, brown sugar and cinnamon on the palate. This is what we call a butter bomb. 100% French Oak; 35% New Oak for 11 months.

Jordan, Chardonnay, Napa Ca 2012, \$16

Aromas of apples, stone fruits, flowers lead to vibrant minerality. Great balance of fruit and oak. 100% French oak for 6.5 months; 42% new oak

Barone Fini, Pinot Grigio, Trentino, Italy 2013, \$10

Crisp and clean, focused on the palate, unoaked, with subtle fruit flavors, balanced acidity, and a lingering finish.

Martin Codax, Albarino, Rías Baixas, Spain 2012, \$10

Aroma of fresh herbs, green apples, citric fruits and grapefruit. Rounded and full-bodied, with bright acidity and fruit.

Manuscript, White Blend, California 2011, \$9

Bright appealing aromas of tropical fruit and crisp green apples. With a balanced acidity and a citrus-laced finish.

New Age, White Blend, Mendoza, Argentina, \$10

Honeydew, melon, apricot flesh and zippy, zesty citrus fruit. Sparkling and sweet.

Kung Fu Girl, Riesling, Columbia Valley, WA. 2014, \$10

Medium bodied, beautifully balanced and finishes cleanly, with perfectly integrated acidity and subtle sweetness.

Innocent Bystander, Moscato Rosé, Victoria, Australia, \$10

Raspberry compote, fresh peaches and vanilla bean with crushed stone fruit. Sparkling, smooth, and refreshing.

Chateau Bonnet, White Bordeaux Blend, France 2012, \$11

Fruity notes, rich, full-bodied sweet dessert wine with apple flavors and creamy finish.

Pacific Rim, Chenin Blanc, Columbia Valley, OR. 2013, \$12

Floral on the nose with vividly bright flavors of pear, quince and grapefruit essence

Dolce by Far Niente, Napa Valley, \$21

This is liquid gold, sweet late harvest wine, peach and pineapple on the palate, a must try.

PS Match Sweet Red Rosso NV, \$9

Rich, juicy flavors of black cherry, strawberry framboise and plum. Semi-sweet red wine with a lively clean finish.

Chandon Rose, California, \$13

Peach, citrus and tropical fruits on the nose and palate, a soft, creamy texture, sparkling.

Stellina Di Notte, Prosecco, Italy, \$10

Delicate aromas of citrus, pear, melon, lemon, and almonds. Elegant bubbles enliven the flavors. The body is light, with a lovely balance between crisp acidity and a touch of sweetness.

Segura Viudas, Brut Cava, Penedas, Spain, \$11

Dry, lively and refreshing, pineapple, almonds and honey with hints of pear.

Moët & Chandon Impérial Brut, Epernay, France, \$17

Green apple and citrus notes with a sparkling bouquet of peach, pear and apple on the palate.

Veuve-Clicquot Brut, Reims, France, \$21

Fruity notes, rich, full-bodied with apple flavors and creamy finish.

Copia's House Jeunette Rouge, Columbia, Missouri, \$7 glass/ \$23 liter

A medium-bodied red wine with fruity character and a soft finish.

William Hill, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, \$9 glass/\$29 liter

Aromas and flavors of jammy dark fruit with hints of blueberry. Traces of brown spice and vanilla.

Bridlewood, Pinot Noir, Monterey County, \$8 glass/\$27 liter

Lush floral aromas that extend to the palate and combine with flavors of raspberry and dark cherry with hints of caramel and toffee.

NxNW, Red Blend, Columbia Valley, \$9 glass/\$29 liter

On the nose currant, cherry, floral, cashew, medium body, well-balanced between fruit and earth. (Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cab Franc)

Lunatic, Red Blend, Napa Valley, \$10 glass/\$35 liter

Dark, concentrated depth, flowing with notes of blueberry and blackberry with the spiciness of vanilla and nutmeg. (Sangiovese, Syrah, Malbec, Alicante Bouschet, Petite Sirah)

Annabelle, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 2012, \$13

Full flavored wine with medium body and rich concentration of fruit. Aromas of black cherry and currant. Perfect for Lamb, beef & cheese.

Stags' Leap Winery, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, Ca 2012, \$20

Aromas of dark fruit. The palate emphasizes balance, round tannins and a finish of notes of espresso and chocolate.

Hess "Allomi", Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, Ca 2013, \$21

Full bodied, with classic Cabernet fruit flavors. Graham cracker, cinnamon, and cedar intertwine with currant and boysenberry.

Clos Du Val, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, Ca 2012, \$19

Culminates with aromas of black fruit and leather. With flavors of berry pie, mocha and Vanilla toast.

Rickshaw, Pinot Noir, California Blend 2013, \$11

Compelling mix of raspberry, pomegranate and cherry notes combined with a stylish integrated structure.

Erath, Pinot Noir, Or 2013, \$13

Freshly baked berry cobbler, citrus and subtle smoke on the nose. Finishing with juicy red fruits and a hint of sweetness.

Michael Dante, Pinot Noir, Ca 2012, \$9

Notes of cherry, cocoa, and vanilla flavors. With ample acidity to bring all of these flavors together elegantly. It finishes with sweet oak and snappy acidity making it a perfect food wine.

Candor, Zinfandel, Paso Robles, Ca N/V \$11

Exhibits aromatics of bright red fruit, vanilla, and all spice. Flavors of strawberry, cherry and licorice integrate well with tannins.

Spellbound, Petite Sirah, Napa Ca 2013, \$13

Rich black fruits, vanilla and coffee aromatics. Starting off with blueberry and vanilla, it finishes with chocolate and coffee.

Cannon Ball, Merlot, Sonoma County, 2013, \$11

Medium-full bodied with classic Bordeaux proportions. Aromas of fresh berries, cayenne spice and dried walnuts.

E. Guigal, Côtes Du Rhône, France 2011, \$11

Deep and dark red. Aromas of fresh fruits with red berries and spices. Full, round and racy. Rounded and smooth tannins. A rich and intensely aromatic wine.

B de Loudenne, Bordeaux, France 2011, \$13

Aromas of fruit and cherry. Flavors of raspberry and raisin, medium body. Round texture with a medium finish.

Brancaia 'Tre', Super Tuscan, Tuscany, Italy 2011, \$13

Plum, spice, black berry and dark cherry on the nose. Dark fruit with a bit of smoke and spice on the palate.

Root: I, Carmenere, Colchagua Valley, Chile 2012, \$10

Ride aromas of black fruits and soft herbal notes. Full-bodied with blackberry, plum and hints of vanilla spice.

Catena, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 2012, \$13

Lush dark fruits, lavender, vanilla, mocha, sweet spice and leather with silky tannins on the finish.

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
